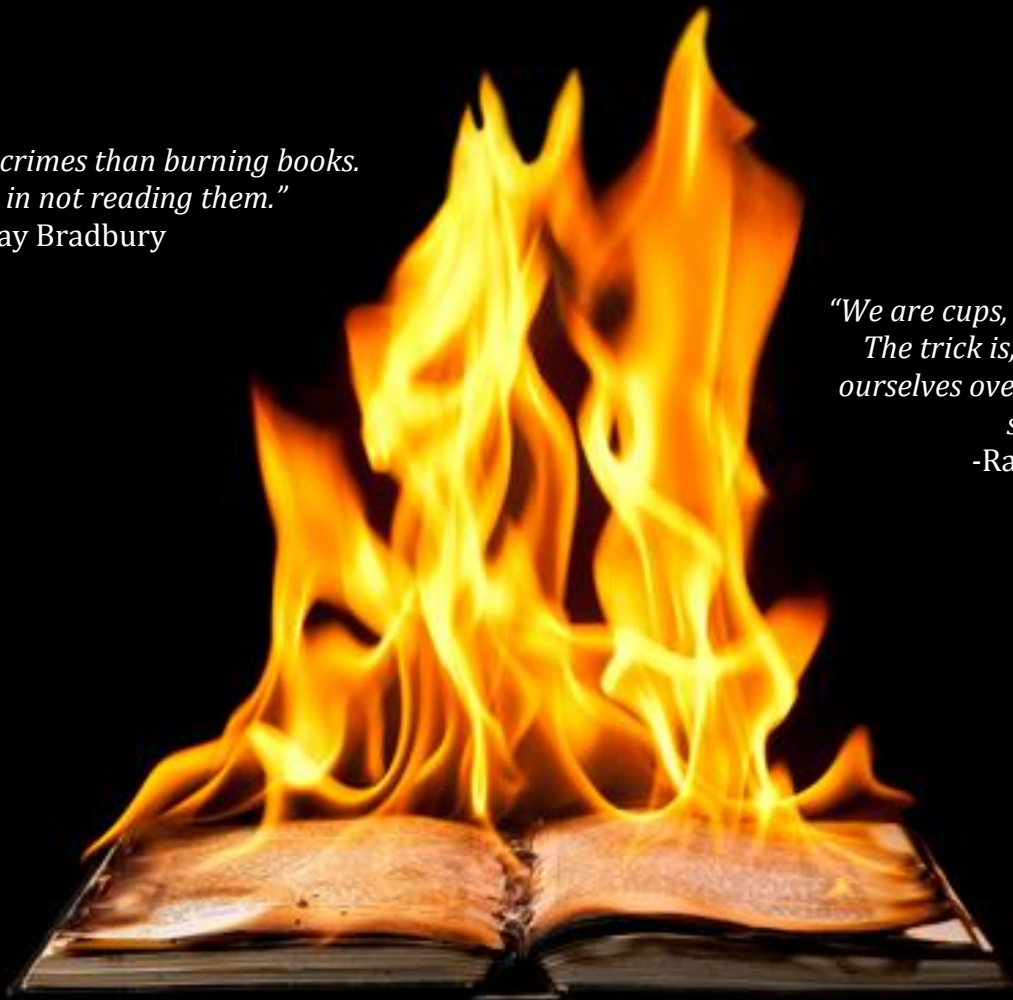
Please join us as we get to know Ray Bradbury and explore through his Novel, "[Fahrenheit 451](#)."

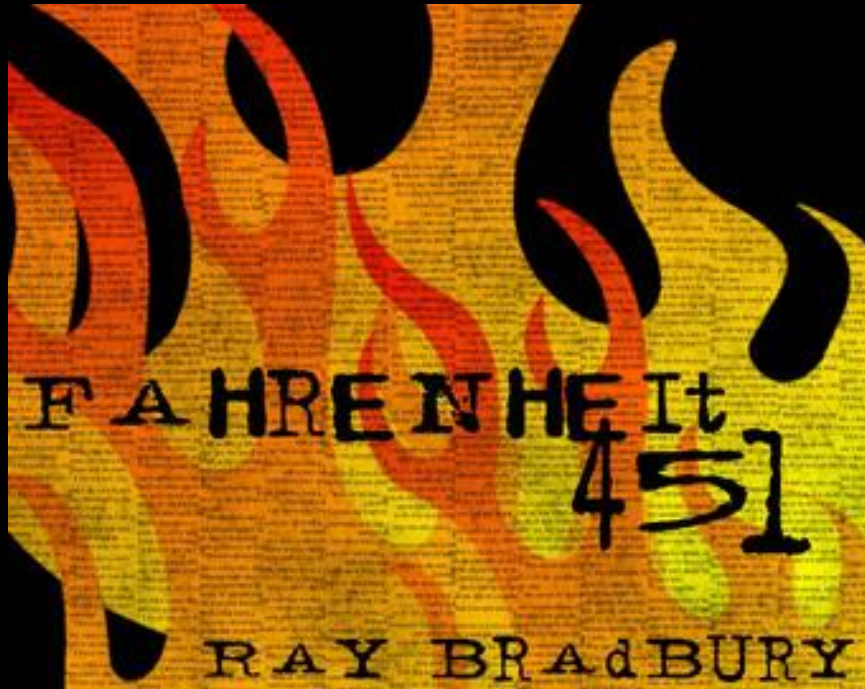
